Key Components of Teaching Literature:

Pre-reading Activity – doing something to get the students into the mood of the story or what it is about

Basic Understanding – introducing the difficult words, and reading with the students the story. Answering LOTS questions (where, when, what, who, how).

Interpretation and looking into Literature - analyzing and interpreting the literary work using HOTS : inferring, distinguishing different perspectives, compare and contrast.

Bridging Text and Context – information about the author and/or the social and cultural background of the literary work.

Post-reading Activity – creative task

Summative Assessment – assessing the students understanding of the story

Reflection/student's response – the students' personal response to the literary work, the activities and the learning process.
